

# CANDLESTICK

**Unique ID:** MAS-D100039

Object type certainty: Certain

Workflow status: Published

Two mass produced glass candlesticks; one blue and one green that is badly damaged presumably having spent at least a century underwater. No further information is known about them at this time.

## Notes:

Along with another candlestick ([MAS-D100041](#)), a gin bottle ([MAS-D100053](#)) and many [ceramic](#) objects, these two candlesticks have been recovered from the wreck of *Josephine Willis*, a New Zealand sail and steam propelled packet ship built in c.1840. The ship was carrying 110 people on board bound for Auckland, comprising ten 1st class passengers, 60 steerage and 40 crew. It sank in 1856 following a collision with *Mangerton* with the loss of 69 lives. NRHE and Kent HER reference numbers cited in this record refer to the wreck of *Josephine Willis*.
